The care of elderly in China

China now has nearly 200 million people over the age of 60. A 2007 study by the United Nations estimated that in 2005 there were 16 retired people in China to every 100 workers. The study projected that this ratio will reach 64 elderly for every 100 workers by 2025. This is a tough challenge to deal with properly and a huge need for additional hospital and nursing home beds dedicated to senior care over the next years.
